FDOT to host open house for Baymeadows Road intersection improvement project

Jacksonville – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is hosting an open house for the Baymeadows Road intersection and safety improvement project that will be starting in January.

The open house is Thursday, December 8, from 5-7 p.m. at the Florida State College at Jacksonville, Deerwood Campus, 9911 Old Baymeadows Road, Jacksonville, Room B-1206.

Those interested can drop by anytime between 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. to learn more about the project including timeframe, construction activities, traffic impacts and other details. Project staff will be available at the meeting to answer questions. Since this is an informal open house, no presentation is scheduled.

The project includes adding capacity to five intersections along Baymeadows Road from Prominence Parkway to Southside Boulevard through the addition of turn lanes and median modifications. In addition, sidewalks will be added on the south side of Baymeadows Road, traffic signals will be upgraded, and drainage and utilities will be improved.

Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, disability or family status as FDOT complies with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
