6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A TOTAL OF
7 \$166,045.00 FROM THE TREE PROTECTION AND
8 RELATED EXPENSES TRUST FUND, TO INCLUDE
9 \$62,205.00 FROM CHARTER SUBFUND 15N FOR
10 PLANTING OF 29 LIVE OAKS, AND \$103,840.00 FROM
11 ORDINANCE SUBFUND 15F FOR THE PLANTING OF 15
12 REDBUD TREES, 8 LITTLE GEM MAGNOLIA TREES, 13
13 EAST PALATKA HOLLY TREES, FOR A PROJECT KNOWN
14 AS "MANDARIN ROAD TREE PLANTING" ON MANDARIN
15 ROAD BETWEEN SILENT CREEK LANE AND FLYNN ROAD,
16 IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 6; DIRECTIVE TO UTILIZE
17 PROCUREMENT CODE FOR SELECTION OF CONTRACTOR;
18 PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO
19 OVERSEE THE PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
20 DATE.

22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2018-2019 fiscal year,
24 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
25 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
26 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

27 (The account information is attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 1**,
28 labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1, Revised B.T., January 2, 2019 -
29 TEU", and incorporated herein by this reference)

4 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - The funding above is being
5 appropriated from the Tree Protection and Related
6 Expenses Trust Fund, Subfund - 15N (Charter) and Subfund
7 - 15F (Ordinance Code) for a tree planting project known
8 as "Mandarin Road Tree Planting" to include site
9 preparation, the purchase and planting of 29 Live Oaks,
10 15 Redbuds, 8 Little Gem Magnolias, and 13 East Palatka
11 Hollies, traffic control during installation, and a one
12 year guarantee and maintenance of the plant material, on
13 Mandarin Road between Silent Creek Lane and Flynn Road,
14 in Council District 6, as shown in **Revised Exhibit 2**,
15 labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised Mandarin Rd Price
16 Proposal, January 2, 2019 - TEU". The project request for
17 proposal shall ask for an additional year guarantee and
18 maintenance as a separate cost.

19 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
20 Section 1 is to provide funding for plantings that will supplement
21 the existing tree canopy and provide shade to the trail/walkway in
22 the City right-of-way, as well as to provide replacement for Live
23 Oaks in two of the medians. The proposed plantings will also serve
24 to reduce storm water run-off and soil erosion, and provide noise
25 reduction and a vegetative buffer to the residences along Mandarin
26 Road.

27 **Section 3. Reversion of Funds.** At the completion of this
28 project, any remaining balances will revert back to the account of
29 origin.

30 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Mayor is requested to appoint
31 the Public Works Department to oversee the project in Section 2

1 above and to ensure compliance with all other appropriate laws.

2 **Section 5. Procurement of Contract Services.** The City is
3 hereby authorized to procure the services of a landscape contractor
4 pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, to
5 complete the project, including the services listed in Section 1,
6 and as shown in **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2,
7 Revised Mandarin Rd Price Proposal, January 2, 2019 - TEU". The
8 project is known as "Mandarin Road Tree Planting".

9 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall
10 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming
11 effective without the Mayor's signature.
