6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A TOTAL OF
7 \$278,872.00 FROM THE TREE PROTECTION AND
8 RELATED EXPENSES TRUST FUND, ORDINANCE SUBFUND
9 15F, FOR THE PLANTING OF 12 OVERCUP OAKS, 18
10 LITTLE GEM MAGNOLIAS, 30 LIVE OAKS, 5 RED
11 MAPLES, 3 TULIP POPLARS, 2 SYCAMORES, 7 EAST
12 PALATKA HOLLYS, 10 DRAKE ELMS, 19 CREPE
13 MYRTLES, 9 FRINGETREES, 14 REDBUDS, 3 VITEX
14 CHASTE TREES, AND 5 PRIDE OF HOUSTON YAUPON
15 HOLLYS, FOR A PROJECT KNOWN AS "SPRINGFIELD
16 PRESERVATION TREE PLANTING", IN COUNCIL
17 DISTRICT 7, IN AN AREA BOUNDED BY 1ST STREET,
18 BOULEVARD, 9TH STREET AND SPEARING STREET;
19 DIRECTIVE TO UTILIZE THE PROCUREMENT CODE FOR
20 SELECTION OF CONTRACTOR; PROVIDING FOR THE
21 PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO OVERSEE THE
22 PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

24 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2018-2019 fiscal year,
26 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
27 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
28 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

8 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - The funding above is being
9 appropriated from the Tree Protection and Related
10 Expenses Trust Fund, Subfund - 15F (Ordinance Code) for a
11 tree planting project known as "Springfield Preservation
12 Tree Planting" to include site preparation, the purchase
13 and planting of 12 Overcup Oaks, 18 Little Gem Magnolias,
14 30 Live Oaks, 5 Red Maples, 3 Tulip Poplars, 2 Sycamores,
15 7 East Palatka Hollies, 10 Drake Elms, 19 Crepe Myrtles, 9
16 Fringetrees, 14 Redbuds, 3 Vitex Chaste Trees, and 5
17 Pride of Houston Yaupon Hollies, and a one year guarantee
18 and maintenance of the plant material, on City rights-of-
19 way in Springfield, in Council District 7, as shown in
20 **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised
21 Springfield - District 7 R/W Tree Planting List, January
22 2, 2019 - TEU". The project request for proposal shall
23 ask for an additional year guarantee and maintenance as a
24 separate cost.

25 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
26 Section 1 is to provide funding for plantings that will serve as
27 replacements for trees that were removed after hurricane Irma and
28 due to general decline within the City rights-of-way. The City's
29 Urban Forestry team collaborated with Springfield Preservation and
30 Revitalization for the planning effort. The trees are planned for
31 locations where homeowners and business owners have requested

1 and/or approved a tree planting in their right-of-way, and all
2 sites have been field verified. Species were chosen to best
3 conform to the existing infrastructure.

4 **Section 3. Reversion of Funds.** At the completion of this
5 project, any remaining balances will revert back to the account of
6 origin.

7 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Mayor is requested to appoint
8 the Public Works Department to oversee the project in Section 2
9 above and to ensure compliance with all other appropriate laws.

10 **Section 5. Procurement of Contract Services.** The City is
11 hereby authorized to procure the services of a landscape contractor
12 pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, to
13 complete the project, including the services listed in Section 1,
14 and as shown in **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2,
15 Revised Springfield - District 7 R/W Tree Planting List, January 2,
16 2019 - TEU". The project is known as "Springfield Preservation
17 Tree Planting".

18 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall
19 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming
20 effective without the Mayor's signature.
